



Dear Friends,

I would like to take this time to personally invite you, your relatives and friends to join us on this special pilgrimage to the Marian Shrines!

Our pilgrimage begins with an orientation tour of Lisbon, Portugal. After, we continue to Fatima, the site of one of the most famous apparitions of the Blessed Mother. On May 13, 1917, three young peasant children (Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco) received an apparition of the Blessed Mother. She gave them many important messages and taught them the need for prayer. These apparitions continued on the 13th of each month until October 13, 1917. On that day the Blessed Mother performed the Miracle of the Sun. Today, Fatima is visited by pilgrims from around the world who search for and find the messages of peace left by Mary for the world.

We will leave Fatima and travel through Spain, along part of The Camino de Santiago (Way of St. James), a large network of ancient pilgrim routes stretching across Europe and coming together at the tomb of St. James in Santiago de Compostela. We will also visit Avila, birthplace of St. Teresa, and Zaragoza, another important place of pilgrimage to honor Our Lady.

From Spain we will cross the Pyrenees Mountains to go to Lourdes, known today as the most famous healing Marian shrine of our times. On February 11, 1858, the Blessed Mother appeared to a young French peasant girl named Bernadette Soubirous. One important aspect of the Shrine of Lourdes is the miraculous water, first uncovered by Bernadette under the direction of the Virgin Mary and said to have a healing effect on many people. The "Miraculous Baths" are open year-round in Lourdes. Thereafter we visit the monastery of Benedictine Abbey of Montserrat and the famous Church of Sagrada Familia in Barcelona.

I hope you will join us along our own custom designed pilgrimage route. It promises to be a rewarding prayerful and memorable journey for all!

Day 1 May 6, Monday: Depart USA

Depart New York JFK International Airport via Delta Air Lines for our overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served in flight. (D,B)

Day 2 May 7, Tuesday: Arrive Lisbon | Fatima

Arrive at Lisbon's International Airport. Go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our private coach bus and soon we will be on our way to Lisbon for an orientation tour of this beautiful city. While exploring the city we will visit the Church of St. Anthony. This is where St. Anthony of Padua, patron Saint of Portugal, was born in 1195. **Celebrate Mass at St. Anthony Shrine.** Independent lunch. After lunch, we will visit the Cathedral which houses the Saint's baptismal font. Next we'll see the Belem Quarter, Discoveries Monument, St. Jerome's Monastery, and Belem Tower. Afterwards, we start our journey from Lisbon to Fatima. Arrive in Fatima and check-in at our hotel. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. **From 9:30 to 10:15pm, participate in the evening Rosary in the chapel of the Apparitions, followed by Eucharistic Candlelight Procession.**

Overnight at our hotel in Fatima. (D)

Day 3 May 8, Wednesday: Fatima | Valinhos | Aljustrel

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we **celebrate Holy Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions.** After, our guide will take us on a tour of the Shrine of Fatima. In May 1917, Our Lady was seen several times by three shepherd children—Jacinta, Francisco and Lucia—at a place called Cova da Iria. Visit the tombs of the children and the Chapel of the Apparitions known as the Capelinha. Continue on to Aljustrel, the hamlet where the three children lived and view their untouched homes. Visit Valinhos where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. Following the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) built by Hungarian refugees that culminates in the Chapel of Calvary. Independent lunch and balance of the day will be free for private devotions. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. **From 9:30 to 10:15pm, participate in the evening Rosary in the chapel of the Apparitions, followed by Eucharistic Candlelight Procession.**

Overnight at our hotel in Fatima. (B,D)

Day 4 May 9, Thursday: Fatima | Coimbra | Santiago de Compostela

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we leave Fatima and drive north towards Santiago de Compostela. En route, we will stop at Coimbra to visit the Carmelite Monastery where Sister Lucia, one of the three shepherd children, lived until her death in 2005. **Celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Monastery.** Independent lunch. After lunch, we will continue on our journey to Santiago de Compostela. Before leaving Portugal behind, we will view Bom Jesus do Monte, Portugal's most photographed church. Late afternoon, we will arrive in Santiago de Compostela which is home to one of the world's largest churches, St. James of Compostela. Santiago de Compostela is also the destination on the important medieval pilgrimage route "The Way of St. James." Check-in at our hotel and have a nice dinner at the hotel restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Santiago de Compostela. (B,D)

Day 5 May 10, Friday: Santiago de Compostela

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, start our tour of the Pilgrim's Way. Walk from Avenida de los Concheiros to Cruz de San Pedro; then to Puerta del Carmen, Rua Casa Reales to Azabacheria; and finally on to the Cathedral, the Shrine of St. James. According to legend, the bones of the Apostle St. James the Great (Santiago) were transported to Spain after his martyrdom in AD 44 and placed at the site of the Cathedral in the year 813. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral.** An impressive feature of the Cathedral is the Portico de la Gloria, located just inside the main entrance. Through the centuries, millions of pilgrims have touched the central pillar. The relics of St. James repose in the high altar. Pilgrims can follow the centuries-old tradition of climbing the stairs behind the altar to kiss the shells that rest on the golden statue of the saint. Below the statue is the crypt that contains the bones of St. James in a silver reliquary. Independent lunch. After lunch, we will have free time to explore the Church and the Convent of San Francisco, which commemorates the pilgrimage made here by St. Francis of Assisi between 1213 - 1215. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Santiago de Compostela. (B,D)

Day 6 May 11, Saturday: El Camino de Santiago | Leon | Avila

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Today, we will travel through the Pilgrims Segment of the Way of St. James into Galicia. Arrive in Leon, capital of Christian Spain at the start of the Reconquista. We will visit the old town and the Churches of Santa Ana, Santa Maria del Mercado, and the Convent of Conception. The highlight of this exploration is the remarkable Cathedral built in pure Gothic style. Tradition requires that all pilgrims rest their hands on a small pedestal in the church, so as to receive special protection for their pilgrimage. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral in Leon.** Independent lunch. Leave Leon and drive south to Avila, City of Kings and of Saints. Check-in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Avila. (B,D)

Day 7 May 12, Sunday: Avila | Zaragoza

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will tour the city of Avila. See the place where St. Teresa was born and baptized. Visit St. Vincent's Church in honor of its martyr, one of the monumental complexes of Avila. Continue on to the Cathedral, which contains many relics of St. Teresa. Proceed to the crypt of the Convento de La Santa, built on the site of where she was born and home to a comprehensive museum, dedicated to her life. Next we will visit the convent of La Encarnación where St. Teresa became a Carmelite. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Transverberation, meaning "Stigmata of the Heart".** After Mass, visit the convent of San Jose, the first monastery founded by St. Teresa. Independent lunch in Avila. After lunch we head to Zaragoza, a monumental town in Spain which was founded over 2,000 years ago. Upon arrival we will visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, an important pilgrimage spot. This is where Our Lady visited Zaragoza before her Assumption. Tradition holds that Our Lady, while still alive, appeared to St. James to encourage him in his evangelization. As a sign of her protection, Mary left him the pillar with her statue. The pillar, which still emits an extraordinary fragrance, can be venerated in the church. Check-in at our hotel and have dinner at the hotel restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Zaragoza. (B,D)

Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

Day 8 May 13, Monday: Zaragoza | Azpeitia | Lourdes

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we head towards Azpeitia and Loyola, to visit the baroque monastery of Ignatius de Loyola, founder of the Jesuit order. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After Mass, continue north-east across the Spanish/French border and through the Pyrenees mountains to Lourdes. Independent lunch en-route. Arrive in Lourdes, where a picturesque castle and the "Grotto" dominate the view. It was in the "Grotto" that the "Beautiful Lady" appeared to Bernadette. At night, people from all nations stroll the narrow streets singing aloud, and laughing. Whether pilgrims experience another miracle or not, they consider it miracle enough to find themselves, at last, in Lourdes. Check-in at our hotel and freshen up. Dinner at our hotel restaurant. **At 9:00pm, we will join in the candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary, and singing of hymns to honor the Mother of God.**

Overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

Day 9 May 14, Tuesday: Full day in Lourdes

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm. English Mass time is advised only two weeks prior to departure. Celebrate Mass at the Grotto.** After Mass, walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette and see the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail, where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous springs, or submerge yourself in the healing baths. Experience Christ's love as you walk the life-sized Stations of the Cross overlooking the holy Grotto. Kneel in the chapel built on the very rock of the Grotto. In a square to the side is the Chapel of Reconciliation, Redemptorist Fathers are available for confessions. Independent lunch. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. **At 9:00pm, we will join in the candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary, and singing of hymns to honor the Mother of God.** The Procession begins at the Grotto and ends in the square in front of the Rosary Basilica. Everyone is invited to carry a lighted candle as a reminder of Baptism.

Overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

Day 10 May 15, Wednesday: Lourdes | Montserrat | Barcelona

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, leave Lourdes for Montserrat. **Arrive in time to Witness the Escolania boy choir singing the Virolai (hymn dedicated to the Virgin of Montserrat) at 1:00pm.** Independent lunch upon arrival in Montserrat, followed by a guided visit of the beautiful Benedictine Abbey of Montserrat. For over a thousand years pilgrims from everywhere in Europe have made their way to the Benedictine Shrine of the Cherished Black Madonna, said to have been carved by St. Luke. Visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat and the breathtaking Benedictine Monastery. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After Mass, continue to Barcelona for hotel check-in and have dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Overnight at hotel in Barcelona.

Day 11 May 16, Thursday: Highlight tour of Barcelona | Farewell dinner

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with an orientation tour of Barcelona, including Sagrada Familia (*Church of the Holy Family*) a remarkable church designed by native Antonio Gaudi. Work on the church began in 1884 but was left incomplete in 1926 due to Gaudi's untimely death. Work resumed in 1940 but to a disadvantage, Gaudi left no plans and no one was able to imitate his style. **Celebrate Mass at Sagrada Familia.** Independent lunch. Continue on to visit to Montjuich Hill, the site of the 1992 Olympics, and enjoy a spectacular view of Barcelona. Continue to the Gothic Quarter to visit the magnificent Cathedral, the Church of Santa Maria del Mar, and the exterior of the Palau de la Generalitat, the Town Hall, the small streets that lead to the Plaza Real, Avenue Paseo de Garcia, and Las Ramblas. Return to our hotel to freshen-up. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner at a restaurant in Barcelona. Overnight at our hotel in Barcelona.

Day 12 May 17, Friday: Return to the USA

After a buffet breakfast, transfer to Barcelona International Airport for our return flight to the USA. Arrive in New York's JFK International Airport early afternoon.

FMA Pilgrimages are accompanied by FMA staff and a Spiritual Director.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check or money order only. In an effort to keep our prices as low as possible, it is recommended that all payments be made via check or money order. However, it is possible to make your final payment via MasterCard, Visa, Discover, or American Express. A convenience fee of \$100.00 per person will apply to your account. Invoices and credit card authorization forms will be included with your welcome documents. The credit card form must be completed in entirety in order for the transaction to be approved.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least **six (6) months**, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed, current and in good condition. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip from **New York's JFK International Airport on Delta Air Lines.** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**\$2,995.00, per person booked in a twin room**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag per person is permitted. Standard airline baggage policies usually allow checked baggage up to 62 total inches and range to 50 pounds and carry-on baggage up to 45 total inches and 11 to 40 pounds. However, policies may vary from the time of printing of this brochure. Contact your airline directly before departure for current baggage dimension allowances. For luggage exceeding the allowed limits, excess baggage fees will apply at check-in. Our final documents will contain current information applicable to your designated airline.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms. Double beds for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are not spacious and no discount is provided. Triple rooms usually are twin bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but

may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of **\$695.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group in some hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, including a **farewell dinner** in Barcelona.

TIPPING/ SERVICE CHARGES: All gratuities to tour manager/guides, drivers, escorts and dining rooms are included. Although these service charges are included, it is customary to leave Euro 1.00 per person to the maid for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, climbing up/down stairs, etc. Any passenger who is physically challenged must submit a certificate from his/her medical doctor stating that he/she is capable of taking part in this pilgrimage without assistance.
