





On this pilgrimage to the Holy Land you will join those pilgrims who, for two thousand years, "have gone in search of the 'footprints' of God that land, rightly called "holy, pursuing them as it were in the stones, the hills, the waters which provided the setting for the earthly life of the Son of God." You will pray in Nazareth at the place where the "Word became flesh" (John 1:14) through Mary's "yes." You will visit the Basilica of the Nativity in Bethlehem, walk around Manger Square, and visit Shepherd's Field. There will be the opportunity to meditate at the Sea of Galilee. We will retrace the steps of Jesus through the holy city of Jerusalem: The Upper Room, Gethsemane, the Way of the Cross, Calvary, and the site of the Empty Tomb!

Our days will include Mass (when possible), reflections, and the opportunity to shop among the local merchants. We will pray for a just peace in the land where Jesus, the Prince of Peace, was born! Please join us on this extraordinary journey of faith. It is our hope that you will say "YES" to this invitation and the most invaluable gift that you can ever give yourself: a pilgrimage to the Holy Land!

Day 1 Sunday, April 30: Depart USA

Depart New York's JFK International Airport for our pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D)

Day 2 Monday, May 1: Arrive in Tel Aviv | Netanya

Late morning, arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport. Proceed through Passport Control and our Peter's Way tour manager, Fabricio Lomanto, will meet the group upon exiting from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Netanya on the Mediterranean Sea for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Netanya. (B,D)

Day 3 Tuesday, May 2: Caesarea | Mount Carmel | Nazareth | Cana

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll drive pass Caesarea by the Sea, the site of a flourishing early Christian community where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader, and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. This is also where St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Continue on to Mount Carmel (*Vineyard of God*) on the Mediterranean coast. Here the triumph of Elijah over the pagan prophets of Baal took place (1 Kings 18). Visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. **Time will be given for prayer at the monastery.** Continue to Nazareth and stop for lunch (cost not included).

We'll visit Nazareth, where Jesus spent his hidden years. Here Jesus lived and learned the Hebrew tongue. Our visit includes Mary's Well, the traditional synagogue that Jesus would have visited as a young boy and as an adult, and more but the highlight will be a visit to the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation built over the house of Our Lady. Here, "The Word became flesh and dwelt amongst us." We will contemplate the mystery of the Incarnation and explore the beautiful basilica built in 1968. We will also visit the house of the Holy Family and use the afternoon for prayer, reflection, praying the rosary, and reading the Gospels. **Celebrate Mass at the Upper Basilica of the Annunciation.** After Mass, we'll continue on to visit Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed his first public miracle, changing water into wine. Visit the Franciscan Church built over the traditional location of the "wedding hall." **Married couples will have the opportunity to renew their marriage vows.** Continue to the shore of the unforgettable Sea of Galilee for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 4 Wednesday, May 3: Around the Sea of Galilee

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will explore the Sea of Galilee and the area of Jesus' public ministry. Begin with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where the Gospels come to life as we imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed

the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). We'll visit Tabgha, a popular fishing spot for locals because of its famous "seven springs" (*Heptapegon*). Tabgha is the traditional location for the calling of the disciples. Here, Jesus walked along the shore and called out to Simon, Peter, and Andrew, who were casting their nets into the sea. Visit the Church of the Multiplication and see the Byzantine mosaic of the loaves and fishes and the Church of the Primacy. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy.** From there we will go to Capernaum, the town of Jesus, to visit the house of Peter's mother-in-law and the first-century synagogue where Jesus taught and performed miracles. We will engage in a discussion on the development of synagogues in Jewish thought and theology to better understand their importance in the public ministry of Our Lord. From there we'll ascend the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

Drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel to the foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, where Jesus appeared to Paul. We will visit Caesarea Philippi and reflect in the place where Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "...But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15). We will reflect here on Peter's response to Jesus, "...You are the Messiah..." (Matthew 16:16).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 5 Thursday, May 4: Mount Tabor | Samaria-Sebastia | Jerusalem

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will drive through the valley of Jizreel to Mount Tabor. Take taxis to the top of the mountain for an utterly commanding view of all of Galilee. It was here that Jesus revealed His glory and divinity to Peter, James and John. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Time will be given for prayer and reflection. Afterwards, continue on to Samaria-Sebastia, a land rich in Old Testament history. Sebastia was built by Herod as the capital of the region and is where John the Baptist was buried after he was put to death. See the twin peaks of Mount Gerizim and Mount Ebal, known in the Old Testament as Mount Blessing and Mount Cursing. Today, Mount Gerizim is the home of the few remaining Samaritans. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

After lunch we will stop at Jacob's Well, the same well mentioned in the Gospel of John. The well is fed by flowing water, which is why ancients gave it the name of "living water." It is at this well where Jesus met the Samaritan woman. Our journey continues "up to Jerusalem" through the beautiful Levonah Valley, referred to in Judges as the Valley of the Dancers. We will pass Shiloah, where the Ark of Covenant was kept. Check-in at our hotel in Jerusalem.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 6 Friday, May 5: Bethlehem | Shepherds' Field | Mount of Olives | Mount Zion

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem, where we can read the biblical account of Ruth, David, and the birth of Jesus. We'll visit Shepherds' Field, where we will see some of the caves that are typical of the stables of that time. The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of St. Jerome in the Basilica of the Nativity.** After Mass we'll visit the Church of the Milk Grotto, where according to tradition, Mary and Joseph stopped to nurse baby Jesus while fleeing Herod's soldiers on their way to Egypt. Free time will be given for shopping and browsing in Manger Square. Group stop for lunch (cost not included). This afternoon we'll drive to the top of Mount of Olives, where the summit offers a magnificent view of the Old City. This visit reminds us of Jesus' last hours in prayer and anguish as He faced His passion and death. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Shrine of Pater Noster, and the Chapel of *Dominus Fleuit* (The Lord Wept). Then, follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Reflect on Jesus' final night. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Continue to the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu. This church is built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Here, Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. Visit the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

Day 7 Saturday, May 6: Baptismal Site on the Jordan River | Jericho | Qumran | Dead Sea

Breakfast at our hotel. After a very early breakfast, **we will celebrate Mass at the Church of the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane.** Then we'll journey to the Judean Wilderness to visit the Jordan River and the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist (Matthew: 3:13-17). It is also considered to be the place where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River and Elijah the Prophet ascended to heaven. **We'll have the opportunity to renew our baptismal vows** (Mark 1:9-11). Continue on to explore Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles, and the Mount of Temptation. Near the center of the city, a centuries-old sycamore tree recalls the incident in which the tax collector Zacchaeus, too short to see over the crowd, climbed a sycamore's branches in order to see Jesus. Group stop for lunch (cost not included). Next, we will visit Qumran, where the hidden library of the Essenes, the Dead Sea Scrolls (currently displayed at the Israel Museum), were found in 1947. Enjoy a panoramic view of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. Visit the Dead Sea with the opportunity to swim or float. On our way back to Jerusalem we will stop at Bethany, where Martha, Mary, and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. Visit the traditional tomb of Lazarus. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 8 Sunday, May 7: Old City & Temple Mount | Ein Karem | New City

After breakfast at our hotel, we will explore the Old City and walk to the area of the Temple Mount. Above the Temple foundations, we will view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Next we'll see the excavation of the Western Wall (Ophel Hill) and walk through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem, seeing the Pinnacle of the Temple (Gate of Hulda). It was here that the disciples preached and baptized after Pentecost. We will also visit the Jewish Quarter, "Cardo." Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

This afternoon we'll make a brief stop at the Monastery of St. John before we proceed to visit Ein Karem, home of Zachariah and Elizabeth, Mary's kinswoman, as well as the birthplace of John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Time will be given for quiet meditation on the meeting between these two mothers, Mary and Elizabeth. Verses from the *Magnificat* are engraved on the columns of the church, and on the wall opposite it are ceramic tablets bearing verses from the *Magnificat* in forty-two different languages. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation.** End our day with a visit to the Israel Museum, which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls, important to our understanding and appreciation of the Bible. Explore an enlightening model of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the days of Jesus. This evening, enjoy a special rooftop dinner at the Pontifical Notre Dame Centre.

Overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 9 Monday, May 8: Via Dolorosa | Emmaus | Late Evening Return to the USA

Early morning, we'll drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate to the convent of the Sisters of Zion. We'll see the Lithostrotos in the chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned by his crucifixion and carried the cross down the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. **Celebrate early morning Mass at the Tomb of Our Lord or the Chapel of Calvary in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre.** After Mass we'll have a guided visit of the basilica and the extraordinary opportunity to enter and exit the empty tomb! Return to our hotel for breakfast and freshen up. Late morning, we'll return to the Old City to visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Independent lunch in Jerusalem. Continue to one of the traditional Emmaus sites. We will recall the story in Luke's Gospel where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road after the Resurrection. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Following dinner, we'll be transferred to Tel Aviv International Airport for our red-eye return flight to New York. Overnight on board. (B,D)

Day 10 Tuesday, May 9: Arrive in the USA

Early morning, arrive in New York's JFK International Airport, overflowing with life-changing memories from our pilgrimage. (B)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check or money order only. In an effort to keep our prices as low as possible, it is recommended that all payments be made via check or money order. However, if you choose to make your balance payments via MasterCard, Visa, Discover, or American Express, you will be charged the credit card package price of \$3,995.00 per person. Invoices and credit card authorization forms will be included with your welcome documents. The credit card form must be completed in entirety in order for transactions to be approved.

CANCELLATIONS/NON-REFUNDABLE PAYMENTS: The \$500.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: It is the traveler's responsibility to have a valid passport for international travel. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. **Beginning in 2023, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU.** After enrolling, if required, you will be sent information to apply for an ETIAS online prior to travel. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all required documents are complete and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents, including passports.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. If you purchase independent connecting flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. However, there is no guarantee that requests will be honored. Peter's Way cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available for purchase (contact our office to inquire). Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package cost is \$2,895.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200.00 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include any portion of the group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying Peter's Way Tours in writing, up to 100 days prior to date of departure. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150.00 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested; with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$895.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, including a special rooftop dinner at the Pontifical Notre Dame Centre.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities for tour manager, tour guides, and bus driver are included in your tour package. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave the equivalent of \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage, or trip interruption. We also strongly suggest that you purchase the Cancel For Any Reason upgrade in order to cover your travel investment for unforeseen circumstances that are not covered by PWT as noted above under OF RESPONSIBILITY. PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the well-being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below). **If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions.** The insurance plan can be purchased at any time thereafter, excluding coverage for pre-existing conditions, until final payment has been made. **Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made.** All plan payments are non-refundable. You can cancel up to 2 days prior to departure and receive reimbursement of up to 80% of the non-refundable payments for your trip.
