St. Peregrine Laziosi: Wonder-Worker

St. Peregrine is the patron saint of those suffering from cancer and other severe illnesses. As a cancer patient himself, he prayed fervently on the night before his leg was to be amputated. That night, he had a vision of Jesus and awoke to find he had been healed! When word of this miracle spread, many came to St. Peregrine for his prayers. Numerous healings have been attributed to his intercession, both during his lifetime and after his death, earning him the title “Wonder- Worker.”

St. Peregrine’s conversion in his youth also makes him a powerful intercessor for those seeking a renewal of faith. As a young man, he was known for his anger and rebellion. One day, he struck St. Philip Benizi in the face, but St. Philip responded by turning the other cheek, following the example of Christ. Deeply moved by this act of mercy, St. Peregrine immediately begged for forgiveness. He later joined the Servites of Mary and went on to live a life marked by repentance, prayer, and service. From his place in heaven, St. Peregrine continues to be a friend to all those who seek his intercession.
